Peter GM4BYF has researched voltage stabilisers and found that the link between pins 3 and 7 on the IO based stabilisers was used as an HT cut-out between the stabiliser and the load. Remove the valve and the low stabilised voltage and the load was protected from overload by being disconnected. The appropriate exhibits have been amended.

The 6P3P (6L6) amplifier with a switch mode power supply (art-263) died after a few hours. The saga of dealing with the supplier is documented.
